

**Memorandum of Understanding
between
Snow College and The University of Central Missouri**

The purpose of the memorandum of understanding is to define a smooth transfer process for Snow College international students to the University of Central Missouri (UCM), both regionally accredited institutions of higher education, for completion of a baccalaureate degree. This document serves for the purpose of outlining application procedures, admission requirements and transfer processes for international applicants.

Under this agreement, UCM will admit qualified Snow College students to the University of Central Missouri who meet the following requirements.

Admission Requirements:

- Completion of a Snow College associate degree **OR** planned completion of a Snow College associate degree prior to enrollment at UCM.
- Student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better and must have a GPA of 2.0 in their last enrollment term at Snow College prior to transferring to UCM.
- UCM qualifying TOEFL or IELTS score OR Completion of Snow College English 1010 and English 2020 and receiving a minimum grade of B to transfer.
- Meet coursework prerequisites for desired major.
- Submit a complete transfer application and all required documents by the applicable admissions deadlines.
- Pay the application fee.

Required Documents:


- Official transcripts from Snow College
- Proof of language proficiency (Transcript with appropriate coursework) or (TOEFL/IELTS)
- Evidence of financial support (bank statement and UCM declaration of financial support)
- Copy of passport Bio page

Upon completion of the above requirements and verification of transfer credits from Snow College to UCM, the applicant will be admitted to UCM for completion of a baccalaureate degree subject to the policies of UCM.

The University of Central Missouri will offer the UCM Global Partnership Non-Resident Scholarship to international students who meet the following criteria.

- Student transfers from an institution that UCM has an active partnership agreement with.
- Student must have a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Students must maintain a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 2.5 or better throughout the program.

This memorandum of understanding is effective on the date of signature and will remain in effect for five years. Either party may terminate this agreement for any reason with 30 days written notice to the other.
